### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS) 2005-2008* and the Caribbean Sailing Association (CSA)
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

### **2 ADVERTISING**

Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the following classes :-

CRUISING 1 (Sails to comply to CSA Rules , Spinnaker Class)

CRUISING 2 (Sails to comply to CSA Rules , Non Spinnaker Class)

CHARTER (Member of recognized charter fleet, sailed as normally equipped, no poled headsails)

FUN CLASS (Assigned temporary Handicaps based on limited measurements Non-spinnaker class)

MULTIHULL CLASS (PHRF Rules)

CLASSIC CLASS (Traditionally built yachts, with long keels and keel hung rudders)

- 3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Le Phare Bleu
